thence down the said branch along the side thereof to Little
Creek and from thence up the said Creek to the beginning
aforesaid, the said Lands hereby intended to be conveyed being

a part of a tract of two hundred acres originally granted
by the said State to one Nicholas Swilla on the 3rd July
1786 and recorded in grant book N. N. N. N. page two hun-
dred and seventy nine, together with all and singular, the
rights, Members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said
premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining
To have and to hold all and singular the said premises
to the said Thomas English his heirs and assigns for ever.
And we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs, executors and
administrators jointly and severally by these presents to
warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said
premises unto the said Thomas English his heirs and assigns
from and against us and each and every of us and our heirs
and every of them and against every person whomsoever law-
fully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

one thousand seven hundred and ninety nine and in the twenty
third year of the independence of the United States of America.
